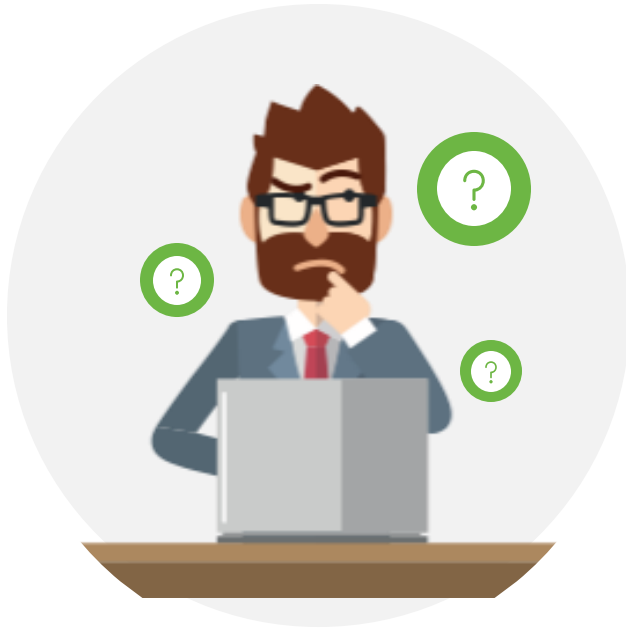

What are my responsibilities at the event?

Volunteering is at the heart of each successful 50-50 Charity Raffle. The 50-50 concept relies on a strong level of volunteer participation at the event to assist with building brand awareness, and most importantly, selling 50-50 tickets - that's where you come in!

All volunteers are tasked with selling 50-50 Charity Raffle tickets to patrons throughout the stadium, either individually or in selling teams.

The more tickets you sell as a volunteer sales force, the higher the overall prize pool and the more funds raised for Rural Lifestyle Options Australia.

About 50-50 Charity Raffle

50-50 Charity Raffle is Australia's only not-for-profit 50-50 raffle that gives fans the chance to play for large cash prizes whilst supporting local charities. 50-50 works with Sporting Clubs and Charity partners to host fundraising raffles at large events, with 50% of the total prize pool going to the winner and 50% go towards charitable purposes.

50-50 Charity Raffle and the Brisbane Broncos

The 50-50 Charity Raffle is essentially a charity raffle held at a home event. Tickets are sold to fans throughout the Stadium during the event by roaming staff and volunteers equipped with handheld electronic mobile devices. Fans can also purchase online via 5050charityraffle.com.au/broncos either before or at the event.

The gross proceeds of 50-50 Charity Raffle tickets sold at the event go into a prize pool. 50% of the prize pool will go to the winner of the random draw, which occurs towards the end of the event. The remaining 50% will be set aside for a charitable purposes.

Every ticket transaction is electronically recorded and updated on the mobile devices on the 50-50 Charity Raffle website, so participants can monitor the draw and the funds raised in real time.

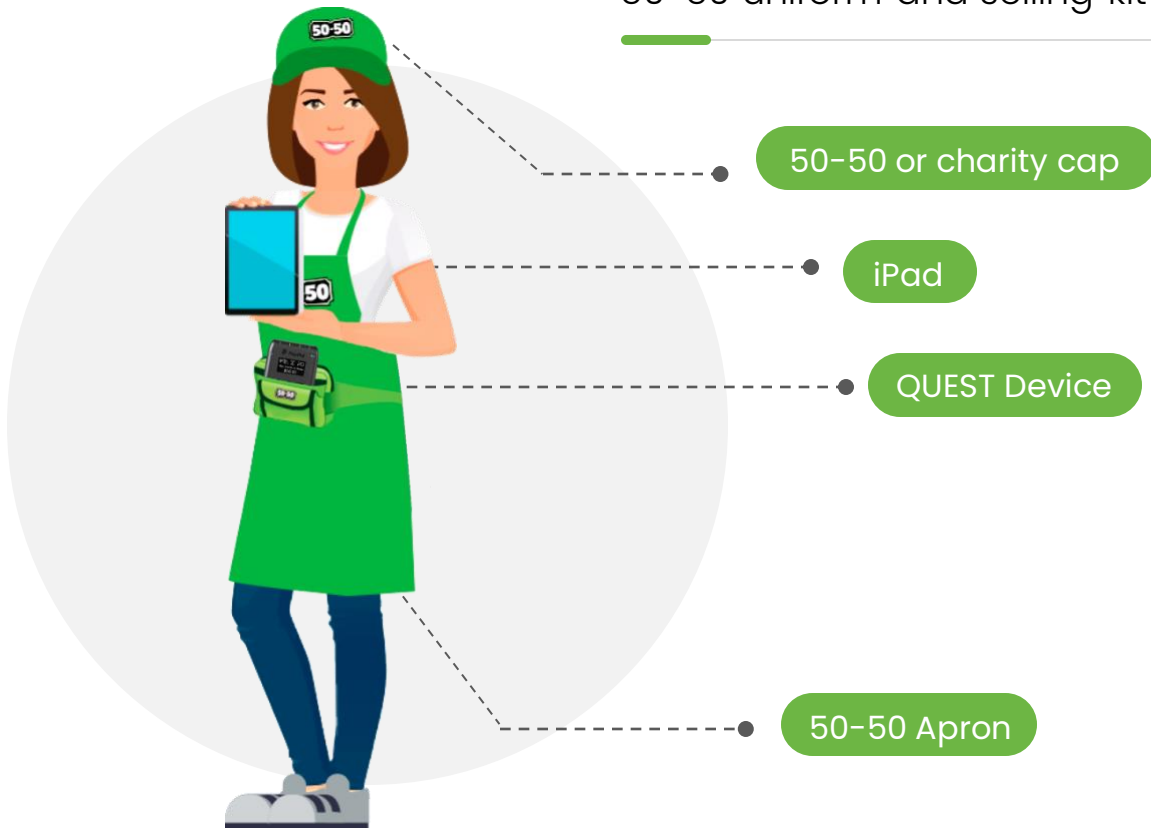

Food & Refreshments

Please bring a water bottle & bring a small amount of cash or your card if you wish to purchase food at the event. Due to catering restrictions, you're not allowed to bring food into the Stadium precinct.



Personal Belongings

You are responsible for your personal belongings. You will be able to leave your belongings in the briefing room while you are out selling, but please only bring minimal personal items/bags.



Alcohol & Smoking

Please note the consumption of alcohol prior to or during your volunteer shift for 50-50 Charity Raffle is prohibited. At the event, you are representatives of both the charity and the 50-50 Charity Raffle and it's important that you refrain from smoking or drinking alcohol for the period of the event and while you remain in 50-50 uniform.



Selling to Minors

Charity Raffle tickets must only be sold by volunteers who are 18 years of age or older.

Ticket sales are not permitted to minors or any person purchasing on behalf of minors.

As a volunteer you should make sure prior to serving a customer that the person is 18 years of age or older. If there is any doubt, you must request identification.



Parking & Transport

There is no parking available at Suncorp Stadium. There is limited street parking in the surrounding streets, but this is not recommended. The best option is to use public transport. For more information visit:
